About EUSA

The European University Sports Association (EUSA) is an umbrella organization that comprises of National University Sports Associations (NUSA) from 47 European countries. EUSA has 15 national university sports bodies as its Members, but also offers possibilities of Universities and other Organisations to join as Associated Members, providing sporting activities, educational events, and expertise in policy making and programming. The organization is well known within the sector as a safe and strong voice for University sports in Europe, promoting fair play values, and supporting their membership by partnering with European Sports Federations and lobbying within the European Union, the Council of Europe and other institutions for funding to improve the provision of sport.





Since its founding in 1999, EUSA has organised 18 seasons of the European Universities Championships (EUC), attracting over 38.000 student-athletes to 174 university competitions held across Europe.

The highest body is the General Assembly, comprised of representatives of the member associations, electing the Executive Committee. Its members are responsible for the administration and running of EUSA and the execution of main directives taken by the Assembly. Anti-doping policy

EUSA is committed to the principles of fair play and upholds the principles of antidoping at all of its events. The GTM will include information about expectations in regards to antidoping matters. Where it occurs and where present at EUC, the MC is responsible for ensuring that WADA Regulations on antidoping procedures are adhered to. Any competitor found to test positive on doping control procedure will be excluded from all future EUSA events for the period of (2) years. In such circumstances a report will be submitted to WADA, ISF, to the rector of his University, National University Sport Association and National Sport Federation. EUSA EC may impose additional sanctions.

EUSA is currently not enforcing doping tests at our events. In accordance with the national legislation of the host countries, however, doping controls may be implemented by the National Anti-Doping Agencies. If such doping tests are executed, the WADA rules and regulations are applicable to all athletes. Please remember that testing can be conducted in-competition and out-of-competition. If you are identified in a Registered Testing Pool (RTP), you must provide current and accurate whereabouts information.

What can you do to be an excellent sportsman or sportswoman?

- Practice right and live healthy
- Get more information about consequences of Doping
- Play fair and be a good role model to younger athletes
- Be committed to sport without doping





EUSA incident policy

One of The Fundamental Principles of Olympism is that "practice of sport is a human right" and that "every individual must have the possibility of practising sport, without discrimination of any kind". This principle further states that this requires a behaviour based on "mutual understanding with a spirit of friendship, solidarity and fair play". EUSA considers sports as an active tool in the education of university students, and aims at encouraging and supporting "the promotion of ethics, Fair Play, gender equity and good governance in sport" (EUSA Statutes). With the EUSA Incident Policy, EUSA clarifies the expectations, and consequences, regarding the behaviour of different stakeholders at EUSA's events to allow the creation of a safe and enjoyable environment.

Fair play

The Championship is a non-profit event, which is carried out in EUSA Spirit and a Fair Play manner, where no discrimination is allowed against any country or person on the ground of gender, ethnic origin, cultural background, sexual orientation, religion or political affiliation. The winners of the competitions are awarded with the title "The European Universities Champion".

Epidemic prevention

If there is a possibility of Covid-19 or other infections arising based on complaints, it is possible to perform a rapid covid antigen test at the medical room of Uni-Hotel dormitory, or to undergo a medical examination in on-call care. In case of symptomatic covid infection, a specialist examination is recommended at the Infectious Disease Outpatient Clinic of the Semmelweis Hospital. In case of confirmation of infection, the athlete may be excluded from the competition according to the decision of the SCAC. The affected person is obliged to comply with the doctor's instructions, such as

avoiding the use of public spaces or wearing a mask. In case of confirmation of infection, isolation is resolved at the Uni-Hotel dormitory. The use of hand disinfectant is strongly recommended at each venues of the event.





GENERAL INFORMATION

About Hungary

Hungary is located in the heart of Europe, in the basin of the Carpathian Mountains. With a population of nearly ten million, it counts as a medium-sized Member State of the European Union. Its capital is Budapest, which is the country's largest city and also its most visited tourist destination.

The country is a member of NATO, OECD and the United Nations, a part of the Schengen area, which allows citizens to travel between countries in the Schengen area without controls.

Hungary is a country rich in natural treasures. One of the world's largest thermal water reserves, the largest thermal lake (Lake Hévíz), the largest body of water in Central Europe (Lake Balaton), as well as the largest grassy steppes of Central Europe (Hortobágy) are all located here. The two major rivers crossing the country, the Danube and the Tisza, play determining roles in the hydrography of Hungary. The highest point of Hungary, Mount Kékes (1,014 m), a place of therapeutic climate and a popular tourist destination, can be found in the Mátra Mountains in north-eastern Hungary.

The area of the country is 93,025 sq.km, with forests covering twenty percent. Hungary's wildlife is one of the richest in Europe. The natural treasures are preserved in 10 national parks, 39 protected landscapes, 174 nature preservation areas and 103 natural monuments.

Hungary is the 11th most popular tourist destination in Europe. Particularly popular areas within the country include Budapest, Lake Balaton and the Danube Bend, but the Tokaj wine region, the Mátra and Bükk Mountains, Debrecen and Hortobágy, as well as Sopron and the Fertő Lake area are also popular.

The country hosts numerous art and music festivals, touristic and sporting events each year. Some examples include "Sziget" (Island of Freedom) Festival in Budapest, the





Flower Carnival in Debrecen, as well as the CineFest International Film Festival in Miskolc.

Throughout history, Hungary has always made significant contributions to the global treasures of culture, in the areas of arts, music, literature, sports and sciences. There is a multitude of natural landscapes of exceptional beauty, historic fortifications, and protected monuments of diverse architectural styles in the country.

Hungarian folk music is famous around the world, and has inspired major composers such as Johannes Brahms, Franz Liszt, Béla Bartók and Zoltán Kodály.

Gastronomy is a noteworthy part of Hungarian culture, which is shown, in addition to the popularity of national dishes, by the wide range of gastronomy festivals. Thanks to the unmatched diversity of Hungarian wine regions, such Hungarian wines have become world famous as the "Tokay aszú", the "bikavér" (bull's blood) of Eger, or the "szürkebarát" (grey monk) of Badacsony.

About Debrecen

Debrecen has a population over 200 thousand, and the city is the spectacularly developing centre of Eastern Hungary.

The name of the town is first mentioned in written records in the 13th century. It was given the rank of town more than 650 years ago, in 1361.

Debrecen was famous across Europe for its fairs and schools. It is located at the crossroads of major routes of transportation across the Carpathian Basin. Fitting to its role as a regional centre, it has excellent accessibility. From Budapest, it can be most easily reached via the motorway system. Railway and bus services connect the city with other regions in every direction.

Debrecen Airport is the only permanently open international airport in Hungary outside of Budapest. It is connected to all major hubs of the continent with scheduled flights. The historic centre of Debrecen offers a fascinating number of attractions and sights

of cultural significance. From the towers of the Great Reformed Church, one can enjoy a wonderful panorama of the city, while the top of the water tower opens up vistas onto the extensive Great Forest. Additional cultural attractions include the Truncated [Small] Church, the 150-year-old Csokonai Theatre, and St. Anna Cathedral. In the library and museum of the Reformed College, founded in 1538, some artefacts unique even around the world are on display: nearly 17 thousand objects are held here, including a collection of applied arts showcasing the treasures of Hungarian silversmiths' works and embroidery culture.



Debrecen is a vibrant and modern city, where one can never be bored. A range of cafés, ambient patios and dance clubs offer the chance of a pleasant evening out. From early spring into late autumn, one music festival is followed by the next.





The services of Aquaticum Spa and Adventure Water Park, based on the thermal water, offer relaxation and thrills alike. Additional venues promising a pleasant time are the Great Forest area with its outdoor theatre, the Mist Theatre fountain, and the "Békás" [Froggy] Pond. It is this area also where Campus Festival, attracting approximately 100 thousand visitors each year, as well as the multiday events of the Wine Carnival and the Jazz Festival, also with crowds in the thousands, are held. Hungary's largest student club, called Hall, was recently opened within the building of "Nagyerdei" Stadium, which is the venue for spectacular, exciting concerts.

University of Debrecen

Today the University of Debrecen is a leading and prominent institution of higher education in Hungary. It is not only at the forefront of Hungarian and international education but also active in the fields of research, innovation and development, and enjoys fruitful links with the business sector. The ever-changing social and economic environment demands continuous renewal from the institution and there is a constant need to adapt to new requirements. The University of Debrecen's mission is to contribute to the education of future generations in cooperation with Hungarian and international partners, with high-quality interdisciplinary programs, and research built on versatile and practical experience.

University sport in Hungary

Hungarian University Sports Federation

The Hungarian University Sports Federation (MEFS) has been founded in 1907 as the second university sports federation in the World and first in Europe, now currently has 34 member universities and 34 sports association members. As the responsible body for the university sports in Hungary, MEFS considers making sports a value and a fashion for young people in higher education a priority task. Following the main strategic lines specified in the Alfréd Hajós Plan 3.0, we can achieve our goals, which will help Hungarian university students in the short term, as well as improve the health conditions of the entire nation and the economy, on the long run.

- MEFS every year organizes between 38 and 40 sports the Hungarian National University Championships (MEFOB), we are every year active in IDUS event organization, coordinate numerous recreation sports campaigns and currently launching the Sports Mentor Programme with 9 universities involved in the project

MEFS higlights in recent years

The greatest highlights in terms of international success were the winning of the organizing rights of the European Unversities Games 2024 Debrecen-Miskolc in 2018, and the pioneer organization of the 2020 FISU World Forum, having been able to attract 106 FISU member countries. In the difficult circumstances caused by COVID-19 MEFS was able to save the event by putting it on an online platform and adapted to brand new organizational tasks in 2 months.

Importance of EUSA events

Year by year MEFS is committed to promoting European Universities Championships and European Universities Games, to delegate the best possible student-athletes to participate, as well as to promote the educational events to involve students in the work and the various projects related to university sports and sports in general. Having the possibility to host the EUSA European Universities Games in 2024, in the next years, MEFS will work on promoting the participation and the engagement of students intensively in university sports in Hungary to organize the biggest Games ever.

EUC 2023 DEBRECEN- Powered by EUG 2024

EUSA started with the European Universities Championships in 2001, with competitions in 2 sports, and the championships' programme has been steadily growing in number of sports and participants ever since.

In 2019, during the last full season of the EUSA Championships, 5242 participants formed 1032 university teams, representing 570 universities from 43 countries, taking part in 21 sports.

In 2023, Debrecen will host European Universities 3x3 Basketball championship, and in 2024 it will host the European University Games together with Miskolc.

VISA procedure

Since Hungary is a member country of the Schengen Zone, all citizens of the rest of EU/EEA member states can enter carrying only an identification document.

Visa-free travel is possible for: citizens of 22 of the 27 Member States of the European Union (Austria, Belgium, the Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Italy, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, the Netherlands, Poland, Portugal, Slovakia, Slovenia, Slovakia, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland and the Netherlands), as well as Norway, Iceland, Liechtenstein and Norway.

Four of the EU Member States - Bulgaria, Cyprus, Ireland and Romania - are not part of the Schengen area.

Citizens of all non-Schengen Member States are required to obtain a visa, which they can apply for at the Hungarian diplomatic mission or consular post of their country of residence or at the diplomatic mission or consular post of a Schengen Member State





acting on behalf of Hungary where they are legally resident for a long stay (holding a residence permit or equivalent visa).

Schengen visa and entry rules apply to short stays of less than 90 days. Rules for stays more than 90 days are determined by the national legislation of each Member State.

We recommend two contact the Hungarian embassy or consulate to check these requirements before travelling.

Athletes and Officials:

- Passport or ID card.
- 2. Individual Entry Form.

Accreditation Card:

The Accreditation Card is the only official and valid document for the participants of 3x3 basketball Championship 2023 therefore, it must always be visible in order to access restricted event areas.

Monitoring of access will be achieved through the Accreditation Cards, which will be checked at all site entrances. People not holding an Accreditation Card or holding a Card which does not have the required access rights will not be allowed to enter. Improper usage of personal Accreditation Cards is prosecutable by law and will be reported to the Security Team.

Loss of the Accreditation Card:

In case of loss of the Accreditation Card, the participant must personally approach the OC Accreditation Center and report the loss by using a valid Identification document (passport or ID card). Inquiries about issuing replacement cards are to be made directly at the Accreditation Center where new cards will be printed. A new Accreditation Card will have the cost of 50 (fifty) euros and will be paid on the spot.


Rules and regulations

The organization of the EUC 3x3 Basketball shall be mainly based on the most recent Technical Regulations of the International Basketball Federation (FIBA)

The draw will be done in the presence of EUSA representative taking into account EUSA 3x3 Basketball ranking. The university team of the hosting city or in their absence the hosting country's highest ranked team will be placed on first (1) place in pool A. Teams from the same country shall, whenever possible, be placed in different pools




